**Sir Edward Youde Memorial Overseas Fellowship / Scholarship
for Disabled Students 2012/13**

Information Note

1. The Sir Edward Youde Memorial Fund (SEYMF) Council is offering an award of Fellowship / Scholarship to finance one outstanding disabled student in Hong Kong for overseas studies commencing in the 2012/13 academic year.

2. The successful candidate will be one who has attained a reasonably high standard of scholastic achievements and has demonstrated his / her ability to maintain health of body and mind; to adapt to new environment; to set a good example for other disabled persons and to be a potential leader in the community. The degree of disability and the need to take up education overseas will also be taken into consideration. He / She is expected to have a strong sense of commitment to Hong Kong and should be able to contribute significantly to the society after graduation from overseas studies.

3. Those who expect to commence full-time postgraduate or undergraduate studies in any tertiary educational and / or academic institution outside Hong Kong in the 2012/13 academic year and who meet the eligibility criteria set out in this Information Note may apply. Application for a study programme leading to a second Undergraduate / Master / Doctoral degree or a study programme being currently pursued will not be considered. Given the very high standard set for this Award, no award will be granted if candidates are considered not meritorious enough.

4. Further details of the Award are given below :-

Name of Award : Sir Edward Youde Memorial Overseas Fellowship / Scholarship for Disabled Students (for studies leading to a postgraduate or undergraduate degree).

Duration of Award : (a) For a Fellowship, up to three years for Doctoral degree or two years for Master degree depending on the length of the proposed study programme and subject to the progress of the successful candidate being deemed satisfactory by the Council.

(b) For a Scholarship, up to three years subject to the progress of the successful candidate being deemed satisfactory by the Council.

Eligibility : (a) An applicant for the Fellowship must fulfil the following criteria :-

- (i) be a permanent resident of Hong Kong;
- (ii) has received at least 7 years of continuous full-time education in Hong Kong;
- (iii) be responsible for fulfilling all application procedures and admission requirements at the institution of his / her choice and be offered a place subsequently;
- (iv) holds a good Honours degree obtained in Hong Kong or equivalent qualification OR expects to obtain such a degree or equivalent qualification before 1.9.2012; and
- (v) has a good mastery of the language in which his / her studies will be undertaken.

- (b) An applicant for the Scholarship must fulfil the following criteria :-
- (i) be a permanent resident of Hong Kong;
 - (ii) has received at least 5 years of continuous full-time education in Hong Kong;
 - (iii) be responsible for fulfilling all application procedures and admission requirements at the institution of his / her choice and be offered a place subsequently; and
 - (iv) has a good mastery of the language in which his / her studies will be undertaken.

The applicant (for both the Fellowship and the Scholarship Schemes) should have special educational needs as referred to in the Hong Kong Rehabilitation Programme Plan released by the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government¹.

Maximum Value of Award per year (subject to review) : (a) Fellowship: HK\$283,000
(b) Scholarship: HK\$262,000

- (c) In addition, a special one-off grant may be given to the candidate upon application for the purchase of study aids or acquisition of supportive services for study depending on the merits of the case.

The Council may adjust the value of the fellowship / scholarship taking into account the actual university fees, necessary living expenses and other awards held concurrently by the fellow / scholar to finance his / her studies overseas.

Conditions of Award : A successful candidate will be required to comply with or agree to comply with the conditions of award should he / she decide to accept any award made under this scheme. In the event of non-compliance in the course of the sponsored studies, the Council may at any time prematurely terminate the Fellowship / Scholarship and he / she may be required to repay such sum, not exceeding the total value of the award so received, and upon such terms as the Council deems appropriate. A guarantor acceptable to the Council will be required.

Furthermore, the award of the aforesaid Fellowship or Scholarship is conditional upon the candidate meeting all the requirements stipulated by the chosen institution and certain language, health and immigration requirements.

¹ Students with special educational needs include those having physical disabilities, visual impairment, hearing impairment, speech and language impairment, attention deficit/hyperactivity disorders, specific learning difficulties, autism spectrum disorders and/or intellectual disabilities.

Selection Procedure : Suitable applicants will be invited to attend a selection interview in Hong Kong in around February / March 2012. Any applicant who has not received an invitation to attend an interview by March 2012 may assume that his / her application has been unsuccessful. The decision of the Council shall be final.

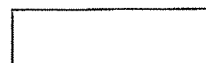
