Program & Application Information Sheet

➤ **Scholarship and Eligibility:**

Scholarship quotas range from two to four per university. The level of sponsorship will depend primarily on the candidate's academic achievement (i.e. cgpa) and a list of selection criteria as outlined below. Application for the scholarship is on a competitive basis and meeting the CGPA requirement does not guarantee the level of sponsorship.

CGPA	Scholarship	Level of sponsorship	Quota(s)
>3.7	Gold	100% out of Tuition Fee	1
3.31-3.69	Silver	75% out of Tuition Fee	1
3.0-3.3	Bronze	50% out of Tuition Fee	2

Remarks:

1. Lehigh University, Global Village only provides 2 quotas
2. Maximum sponsorship per scholarship is HKD\$30,000

Selection criteria:

Successful candidate will need to go through two rounds of panel interview. Selection criteria may include the followings:

- i) academic performance and attendance
- ii) other academic achievement (e.g. public examinations, awards, etc.)
- iii) level of independence and self-motivated learning
- iv) ability to establish a concrete plan of the trip
- v) presentation skills (e.g. verbal articulation)
- vi) appearance (e.g. dress code for interview)
- vii) participation in School services/activities
- viii) lecturer and/or programme staff references

➤ Program information:

 - (a) Application form, with (b) parent reply slip, (c) your HKID & (d) HKSAR passport copies

- 2) Sign-up for the 1st round Interview Session and may need to attend 2nd round Interview Session**

- 4) Successful Applicants will be notified in person via email and phone, and**
 - i) Pay the \$5,000 Deposit at Counter**
 - ii) Program Specific Briefing Session with Parents**
 - All important information (including the Student Agreement, Undertaking & Parental Consent Forms) will be given in the meeting
 - iii) Attend the program trainings & meetings**
 - * During the trainings & meetings, students will be assisted in program registration/application, visa application, insurance, air fare, departure preparation, etc.
 - iv) Once the participant has successfully enrolled in the program and been granted a valid visa (if applicable), s/he will be asked to pay the program fee.**

- 5) Higher Diploma Academic Performance: Achieve cGPA 3.0 or above
