- 2. 評估有關可能並存的專注力及情緒行為問題
- 3. 其他有關跟進服務

為配合個別家庭需要,本會亦可由註冊臨床心理學家提供有關評估及心理輔導服務。

# Clinical Psychology Support Service

Our mission at The Pathways Foundation is to address the widespread educational, personal and societal issues that arise from specific learning difficulties (SLD) in school age children.

Our Clinical Psychology Support Service (CPSS) provides professional support to parents and children. These include assessments and counselling for students with SLD by a qualified clinical psychologist. We also conduct information seminars on SLD to parents and teachers.



#### **Assessment Services**

- students who are suspected to have SLD
- 2. students who wish to update previous assessments

## Target

Primary (aged 6 years and 1 month or above) and junior secondary students
\*Case by case arrangement is needed for senior secondary students



- Intake interview with parents
- Intelligence test
- Administration of The Hong Kong Test of Specific Learning Difficulties in Reading and Writing / other tests for SLD
- Written report and post-assessment briefing with parents

# Follow-up Assessments / Consultations

Depending on students' needs, the following additional services are provided for students after they have completed the above package:

- 1. Additional cognitive and learning evaluations related to SLD
- 2. Assessment for co-existing behavioral or emotional issues
- 3. Other follow-up consultations

# **Counselling Services**

To meet various needs of individual families, assessments and counselling services are also provided to students and/or parents by a qualified clinical psychologist.
