After School Support Programme

Atelier Arts & Potential Development Programme

Develop potential of SLD students through visual arts, performing arts and digital media.

Clinical Psychology Support Service

Provide students assessment, counseling and psychological counseling.

Parent Education

Provide workshops for parents, providing knowledge about learning disabilities, and support strategies and techniques.

About Specific Learning Disabilities

Students with specific learning disabilities have normal intelligence. These disorders are intrinsic to the individual and they are neurobiological in origin. They begin in childhood and continue beyond it. Significant problems arise in their listening, speaking, reading, writing, computing. The most common learning disability is dyslexia. The difficulty lies in working memory, processing speed, word recognition, dictation, text difficulty spelling, reading comprehension and so on. Some of the students may have mathematics disorder that they find it difficult in dealing with mathematical concepts.
